As residents of Claygate know, it has been a long road to get to this point since the former clubhouse burned down in 2017. We hope you agree that we now have a purpose-built Pavilion which serves the public and our community well; from the multi-use 'Treetops' room and changing rooms to the first-rate Pistachios café, bar and terrace, this is a unique resource at the heart of our community.

We are hugely grateful to the residents of Claygate for the support you have all shown as we have completed this major project. Those who contributed to the rebuild can find their names on the Claygate Community Oak in Treetops Room on the first floor of the Pavilion.

FAMILY GARDEN POPULAR WITH POLLINATORS



Following the completion of the Pavilion, the Trust began work on the Family Garden which sits in the Northwest Corner of the Rec. Selina Botham created the concept design and Rachel Jones, one of our Resident Trustees worked from this to create the plan we have today.

The garden has plenty of quality seating including picnic tables and benches. The hard landscaping is complemented by native species of plants which are great for pollinators, and we expect to see lots of local wildlife as the garden matures. Several of the benches and tables have been supported by friends of the Rec, so you can look for inscriptions as you enjoy the garden.

Bring a picnic or get a takeout from Pistachios in the Park café and make the most of this purpose-built space.

The CRGT is grateful for support of the Claygate Parish Council, Your Fund Surrey, The Werth Trust, Claygate Village Association, the Tree Council and all those who supported a bench to help us build the family garden.

CLAYGATE THROUGH THE SEASONS

One of the wonderful things about our community is how many talented people there are willing to get involved and enrich our collective life with the skills. One of these people is renowned local artist Richard Knight who dedicated his time and expertise to complete an art installation for the Pavilion which was revealed to the public at an event on 14th January. Richard's wonderful painting 'Claygate through the Seasons' shows an arial view of the Rec in both summer and autumn – an imagined day on which both football and cricket are being played and the trees are both in full, summer leaf, but also a blaze of autumnal russet colours. Speaking at the opening Richard said: "I had great fun using my new drone to capture various images of the Rec which I then based my painting on. The Rec is the heart of our community and I hope Claygate residents feel I've captured the magic of this important, public space."

Helen Maguire, Chairman of the CRGT said: "We're very grateful to Richard for contributing his time and amazing skill to crate this wonderful painting which shows the Rec in all its glory."

HOW TO GET INVOLVED

There are a number of ways to get involved in the club so please contact us if you are interested in participating.

We are looking for umpires, team managers and volunteers with skills in areas such as social media, marketing and communications.

JUNIOR CRICKET

Our cricket starts from age 5 and upwards through the ECB All Stars and Dynamos programmes.

We are increasing our levels of professional coaching and are planning an extended junior season to provide as much cricket as possible to our junior members.

The Claygate Diamonds are our girls cricket sides which are growing quickly. Expanding girls cricket is a key focal point for the club.

There is also an opportunity for players, who are involved in the Duke of Edinburgh programme, to volunteer with the club.

2022 age group side subscriptions will include the new coloured kit with players receiving a shirt, trousers and cap.

ADULT CRICKET

We run mid-week and weekend sides playing league and social cricket across long and short formats.

We are excited to introduce a new Development side in 2022. It will be a way for juniors to transition to adult cricket and will provide social players, or those returning to the game, the opportunity to get involved. The side will play friendly games in a relaxed atmosphere ranging from T10 matches to 25 overs-a-side.

Our flexible subscription model caters for occasional players who cannot commit to regular involvement.

The Trust has also installed new bins around the Rec as well as two new noticeboards at the Dalmore Avenue entrance, along with wonderful bike stands created by Claygate's very own Giles Totton. A new awning was installed on the Pavilion on 26th Jan which will provide shelter from the sun and rain for those enjoying food and drinks on the Pavilion terrace. We know that the acoustics in Treetops have been a problem and so we have just installed baffles to ensure a calmer atmosphere. The path between Dalmore Avenue and the Pavilion has been retarmacked and we have

The Claygate Recreation Ground Trust is lucky to have had many dedicated and talented trustees since it was established in 1998. We owe a lot to the hard work and voluntary support of people who are determined to bring positive and lasting changes to this vitally important community facility. It is always sad when we have to say goodbye to trustees, but we recognise that there are other good causes they want to spend their precious time focused on.



We want to pay a very special tribute to **Helen Maguire**, who for the past 8 years has served as the Chair of the Trust. Helen has decided that with the Pavilion and family garden complete, it is time to stand down and focus on other things. Under Helen's leadership and thanks to her vision, the Trust has

gone from strength to strength. It was Helen who led the work with other trustees to rebuild the Pavilion after the devastating fire in 2016 that resulted in the demolition of the previous pavilion including leading the fundraising, ultimately raising over £450,000 for the Trust. Helen has inspired and cajoled, persuaded and argued to ensure that the building we have today is one that is greatly valued and will bring lasting benefit to our community. We are deeply grateful to Helen for all she has done, and we hope she will continue to be involved in some way with our work.



We also need to say a huge thank you to three other trustees who are moving on: **Tracy Scott** our current vice chair who has been at Helen's right hand side for the whole of the rebuild project and without whom the project would never have been completed; **Sam Ahmed** our treasurer who we can thank for the works being completed on budget and **Damian Ross** who has spent over 10 years on the trust as the Cricket Club representative and a resident trustee. We are grateful to Damian for his tireless service which has saw him start the Gig on the Rec event, manage the relaying of the cricket square, undertake countless fundraising drives, and possibly most importantly (according to Damian) kept the Rec stocked with dog-poo bags!

A huge thank you to all of you for all you have done for the Rec, the trust and the whole community owes you a great deal.

SO... WHAT'S NEXT?

At a meeting in January the Rec trustees agreed a list of priority projects they would like to undertake when capacity and funding permits. The top three were sorting out the drainage by the Claygate Primary School Rec gate, improving the lighting on the path from Church Road to the Pavilion and overall pitch drainage. Other areas being considered are removing the mound by the playground that was left after the Pavilion rebuild, adding solar panels on the Pavilion roof, creating a pathway around the perimeter, and working with Elmbridge Council to renew the playground. Some of these are relatively complex and expensive projects so as we prioritise, our aim is to make our Rec an even more pleasurable place to spend time.




Events can be catered for by directly contacting our inhouse café, **Pistachio's in the Park**, and an after-party cleaning service can be provided for large functions.
